



## Financial Assistance Application

Poverty guidelines provided by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services are used to determine a patient's eligibility for assistance. If a patient qualifies, the discount will be honored by all GP locations however, exclusions may apply for elective services. Patients who do not have insurance will receive a 30% discount.

Please provide the following documentation:

1. Verification of immediate household members. Please provide at least one document for each member listed.

(Spouse, Child, Step-Child, Grandchild, Father, Mother living under the same roof)

- Driver's license or state issued ID
- Birth certificate
- Custodial court documents
- Immigration papers
- Tax return (Only page showing dependants)

2. Verification of income. Provide all income, from all sources for the past four weeks. Proof of income is required from patient and all immediate household members over the age of 18.

- 1 month of pay stubs
- Proof of cash income
- Proof of unemployment benefits
- Wage history report from the unemployment office, if no income is reported
- Social Security benefits letter
- Disability benefits
- TANF (welfare assistance program)
- Child support
- Food Stamps

3. Documentation of all other sources of assistance that have been exhausted such as Medicaid, HIP, and third party sources. (if applicable)

Please return these documents and completed application within 2 weeks. If approved, you will be eligible for assistance for 12 months. After that time, you will no longer receive the discount until you provide an updated application with documentation.
