

MEDICATION DISPOSAL



Dispose of medications safely at Goshen Hospital

Protect your community from prescription drug abuse by safely disposing of your unwanted medications. Drugs that are thrown in the trash can be retrieved by others and sold, while flushing medications can potentially contaminate the water supply. To help you safely dispose of your medications, look for the MedSafe kiosk located in the main lobby.



Accepted – prescription medications, over-the-counter medications and liquid medication bottles: all in original packing if possible



Not Accepted – illegal drugs, needles/syringes or sharps containers, medical devices, batteries, aerosol cans, inhalers, chemicals, mercury-containing devices, radio-pharmaceuticals and liquid antineoplastic agents
