Use this form to identify the student's risk of exposure to COVID during clinical rotations at Goshen Health. Our goal is to minimize potential exposure, providing appropriate PPE for the student while conserving resources for future needs.

Exposure Risk – Need for N95 Fit Testing

Will the student need to enter airborne isolation rooms to complete their clinical rotation requirements?

- Yes – the student must complete N95 fit testing and receive an N95 mask kit. Information about the mask re-use will be given when the kit is provided in their department
 - Department leader will communicate the number of students needing fit testing and deadline for testing to HR using this link.

 - After receiving confirmation that fit testing is available, provide the student with the Time to Sign Up link to schedule their fit testing appointment in HR:

 - Before fit testing: Enter the student's name, start date and end date in the fit testing tracking spreadsheet
 - When distributing the mask kit: Enter the date the mask kit was given in the fit testing tracking spreadsheet
- No – the student will not complete N95 fit testing or receive a mask kit. The student will not enter any room where airborne isolation precautions are in place.

Mask Kit

If the student must complete N95 Fit testing, use the following section to determine if a full kit or half kit is needed. Masks are worn an entire shift when in airborne isolation rooms/ COVID unit. The masks are stored for at least 72 hours prior to wearing again.

Guidelines for mask kit:

- 3 or more days per week: Full Kit (4 N95s)
- 2 or less days per week: 1/2 Kit (2 N95s)
